1. Discuss the factors that will hinder a Kenyan woman from successful political election to presidency and highlight **five** strategies that will enable her to ascend to presidency.

2. Kenyans have a tendency to watch leaders lead with impunity while plundering public resources but do very little to advocate and hold these leaders to account.
  - (a) Discuss **five** factors contributing to this behavior. (10 marks)
  - (b) Explain **five** strategies that will motivate Kenyans to be proactive in effective policy implementation and political transformation. (10 marks)
3. Tribalism has always played a major role in determining the direction for Kenyan voter outcomes. Discuss **five** major social injustices that emanate from tribalism and explain strategies that will mitigate tribalism. (20 marks)
4. The Kenyan 2010 Constitution has major provisions to support gender equality. Identify any **five** provisions which are having major difficulties being implemented and explain why they are hard to implement. (20 marks)
5. What can Kenyan environmental planners learn from Prof. Wangari Maathai's work and experiences and what **five** strategies can gender sensitive policy makers put in place to ensure that women do not have to experience so much trauma? (20 marks)
