- c) Explain the purpose of needs assessment and the process one has to follow in conducting needs assessment.
- d) Describe the guidelines used in the evaluation of language learning resource materials.
- e) Explain the term “psychometric” and “integrative” as applied to language testing, illustrating your answer with examples of appropriate questions.

- a) Monitoring and evaluating progress in language learning are components of curriculum, as well as language teaching and learning. Explain how a teacher can use four different types of tests to collect data about the learners' progress.
- b) Explain briefly how testing is currently being conducted in secondary schools in Kenya, and discuss five purposes of conducting English language tests.
