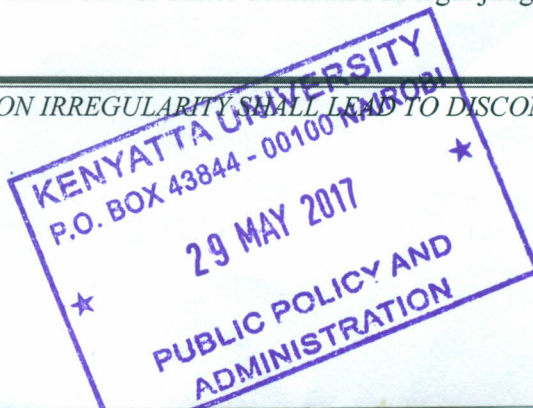
- (a) State and explain 4 theories of ethics. (8 marks)
